

02. The sanction is subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a. The tour will be treated as on duty ;
- b. All expenses in this connection shall be borne by CTM Joint Venture.
- c. The officials will draw their pay and allowances in local currency; no part of it shall be drawn in foreign currency;
- d. They will not be allowed to stay abroad more than the approved period;
- e. They will have to submit a report to the Ministry of Railways after completion of the tour.
- f. Mr. Md. Mofazzel Hossain, Secretary in-Charge will be accompanied with his wife Dr. Showkat Ara, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Neuroradiology & Imaging, National Institute of Neurosciences & Hospital, Sher-E-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka during the visit but the cost in this regard shall be borne by himself from his own fund.
